These funds allow us to offer financial assistance throughout the year for the care of pets belonging to low-income senior citizens who meet the following requirements:

- **Over the age of 65**
(proof of age required such as copy of Driver's License, etc.)
- **A permanent Coachella Valley or Morongo Basin resident**
(proof of residency required such as copy of Driver's License, utility bill, etc.)
- **Maximum income not exceeding \$1,700 a month for one person**
(proof required such as copy of bank statement, Social Security statement, etc.)
- **Proof of ownership of animal**
(such as vaccination records or license)



Pet owners who meet **ALL** the requirements listed above may apply for our Seniors' Pet Wellness Program to reduce the cost of their pets' veterinary care.

While qualified pet owners will receive some financial aid, this program *does not cover the entire cost for services.*

Only pets belonging to the qualifying senior can be treated with this funding. Assistance is only available as long as funds are available.
